Worm composting (or vermicomposting) relies on worms to make soil, while home composting relies on bacteria.

More benefits of composting:

- Closes the gap on emissions from methane, a more potent greenhouse gas than carbon, from food waste in the landfill.
- Revitalizes your soil's health without synthetic fertilizers.
- Fun way to engage with science and nature.

FOOD DISTRIBUTION



The Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano County will be providing free bags of fresh produce every second Monday of the month. The next drive-thru distribution is **Monday, May 8, 2023, from 9 AM to 11 AM** (or as supplies last) at the Pinole Senior Center parking lot, 2500 Charles Ave. You do NOT need to be a member of the Pinole Senior Center or a senior to receive food. One bag per household.

This will be a contact-less event, please follow the directions from staff and volunteers when you arrive. Parking or exiting your vehicle will not be allowed. Please open your vehicle's trunk when you enter the parking lot. Food items will be placed in the trunk only by staff/volunteers. SENIOR FOOD PROGRAM

The Pinole Senior Center will be partnering with the Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano County on the Senior Food Program. Low-income senior citizens 55+ will be able to receive free groceries, including healthy pantry staples, eggs, cheese, and assorted meats twice a month. The program at the Pinole Senior Center is available for Pinole senior residents ONLY. It will be every second and fourth Tuesday of the month. The next distribution will be on **Tuesday, April 25, 2023, from 10:00 am - 11:00 am.**

Individuals interested in the program must complete the Senior Food Program Application. Applications will be available at the Front Desk of the Senior Center and can also be found on the Pinole Senior Center website: https://www.ci.pinole.ca.us/city_government/senior_center

Applications can be submitted to the Pinole Senior Center Front Desk Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 am - 1 pm and on the day of the food pick up. Individuals must bring proof of age such as an ID or Driver's License and

PLASTIC WISE PINOLE: SINGLE-USE PLASTICS REDUCTION



A vision for a healthier and cleaner Pinole! The City of Pinole is currently working on an initiative, Plastic Wise Pinole, in the hopes of transitioning Pinole

away from single-use plastic bags and foodware. Single-use plastics are unhealthy and unsustainable for our well-being as well as our planet's. Microplastics can be found in our blood. A trash study of the Pinole Creek found single-use food packaging to be a major pollutant.

Two surveys are live: Resident/Visitor and Business Survey to gather the public's thoughts on regulation of single-use plastics. Surveys will take approximately 5-8 minutes to complete.

The "Community Corner" lot at 2301 San Pablo Ave (corner of Tennent and San Pablo Avenues) is in the heart of the City of Pinole. Formerly a gas station, the property has been remediated and has been a vacant property under City ownership since the 1990s. Past ideas for use of the property have included mixed-use development with ground floor retail, as well as a community park or gathering center. The City is conducting this current effort to gather community feedback to determine the best use for the property which will benefit the Pinole community.




