CITY COUNCIL RECOGNIZES LBGTQIA PRIDE MONTH

At its meeting of June 7, 2022, the City Council issued a proclamation declaring June 2022 as LBGTQIA (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, Intersex, and Asexual) Pride Month in Pinole. Celebrating Pride Month influences awareness and provides support and advocacy for the City of Pinole's LBGTQIA community.

CITY COUNCIL RECOGNIZES JUNETEENTH

At its meeting of June 7, 2022, the City Council issued a proclamation declaring June 19, 2022, Juneteenth in Pinole. Juneteenth or Black Independence Day commemorates African American freedom and emphasizes education and achievement. It is a day marked with celebrations and family gatherings and is a time for assessment, self-improvement and for planning for the future.

CONSIDERATION OF CHARTER CITY MEASURE & REAL PROPERTY TRANSFER TAX

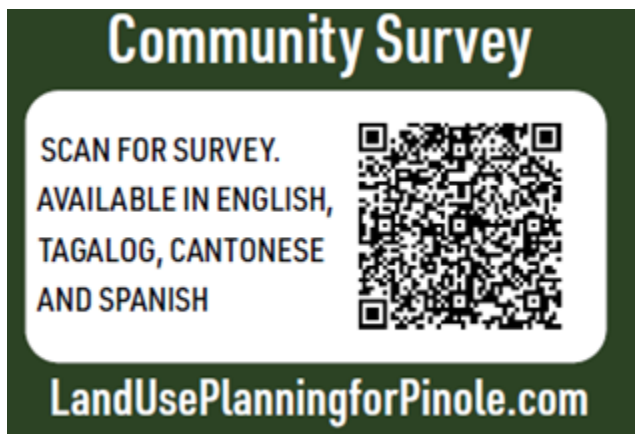
At its June 7th meeting, the City Council considered placing a measure on the November 8, 2022, ballot for voters to decide if Pinole should become a charter city and enact a real property transfer tax (“RPTT”). The RPTT is a tax paid only when a property is sold and would be calculated as 0.8% of the sales price. The draft charter considered by the City Council is limited in scope and would not authorize the city to exercise any additional powers unless approved by the voters. The City Council will be considering the potential ballot measure again at a special meeting on July 12 at 6:00 p.m. Members of the public are invited to attend the meeting and provide input to the City Council.

CONSIDERATION OF FINAL PROPOSED FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

The City of Pinole’s Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) is a five-year plan for maintenance and expansion of the City’s public facilities and infrastructure. At its June 7th meeting, the City Council reviewed the Revised Proposed FY 2022/23 through FY 2026/27 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) and provided staff direction and feedback. The Final Proposed CIP for FY 2022/23 through FY 2026/27 will be presented to City Council for review and adoption at the upcoming June 21, 2022, Council meeting.

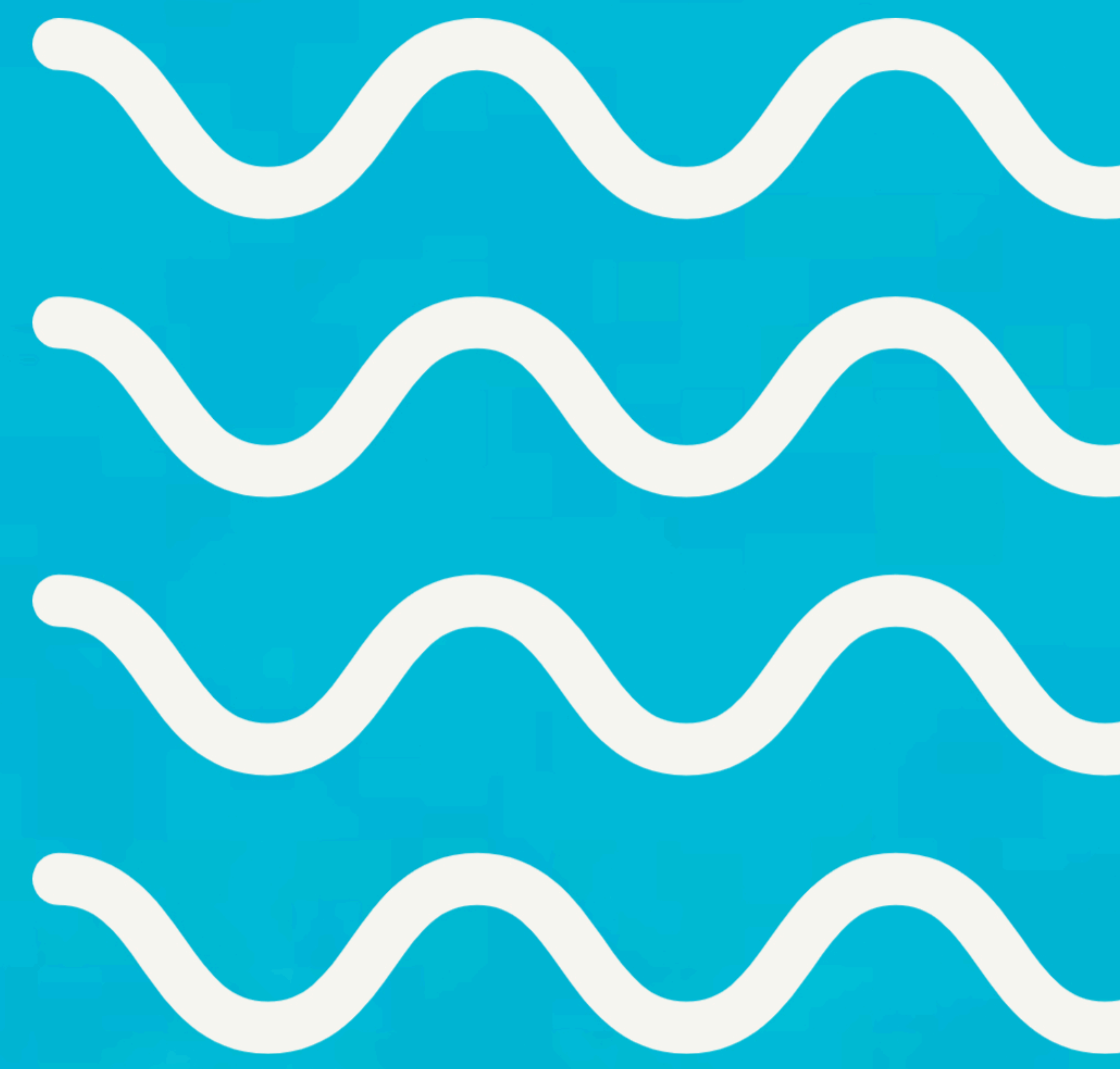
