
### COVID-19 VACCINES APPROVED FOR KIDS UNDER AGE 5

### **SENIOR FARMERS' MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM (SFMNP)**

The Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) is a federally funded program which provide low-income seniors with check booklets that can be used to purchase fresh, nutritious, unprepared, locally grown fruits, vegetables, honey, and herbs at select local farmer's markets in Contra Costa County including our very own Pinole Farmer's Market.

All seniors 60 years of age or older who's annual income does not exceed more than 185% of poverty level are encouraged to apply. The exact annual income is broken down to the following based on the family size:

- Family of 1 - \$25,142
- Family of 2 - \$33,874
- Family of 3 - \$42,606
- Family of 4 - \$51,338
- Family of 5 - \$60,070
- Family of 6 - \$68,802
- Family of 7 - \$77,534
- Family of 8 - \$86,266

The Pinole Senior Center will be a designated site that will distribute the SFMNP check booklets. Each participant will be given five (5) checks redeemable for \$10 each.
